POSITION SUMMARY

Under the direct supervision of the Clinical Director, the Associate Therapist shall provide clinical services to clients of Domestic Violence Solutions.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Be knowledgeable of and follow all legal and ethical guidelines set forth by the Board of Behavioral Sciences for the State of California. This includes, but is not limited to confidentiality, mandated reporting and dual-relationships.
- Complete 40-hour Domestic Violence Training.
- Provide individual, family group and play therapy for DVS clients as assigned by Clinical Director.
- Complete all client documentation in a timely manner.
- Seek clinical support when needed and follow directives of Clinical Director.
- Participate in weekly clinical supervision and weekly case management meetings.
- Provide monthly statistical information to Clinical Director.
- Complete BBSE hours monthly for Clinical Director signature.
- Be available for emergency clinical support when possible.
- Arrive to scheduled sessions and meetings in a timely and prepared manner.
- Participate in agency outreach and 40-hour Domestic Violence training presentations.
- Complete accurate billing records.
- Others as assigned
