# Clinician Job Description

#### **POSITION SUMMARY**

The Clinician shall provide clinical counseling and educational presentations to shelter and community clients. This position is 40 hours. The position is based in South County with offices in South County.

#### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Be knowledgeable of and follow all legal and ethical guidelines set forth by the Board of Behavioral Sciences for the State of California. This includes, but is not limited to confidentiality, mandated reporting and dual-relationships.
- Provide Clinical counseling, crisis management and client interventions as assigned.
- Complete 40-hour Domestic Violence Training.
- Provide individual, peer group and educational presentations for DVS clients as assigned by Clinical Director.
- Complete all client documentation in a timely manner.
- Seek clinical support when needed and follow directives of Clinical Director.
- Attend weekly case management meetings.
- Provide statistical information to Clinical Director.
- Be available for emergency clinical support when scheduled by Clinical Director
- Arrive to scheduled sessions and meetings in a timely and prepared manner.
- Participate in agency outreach and 40-hour Domestic Violence training presentations.
- Complete accurate billing records.
- Others as assigned

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE: A Master's degree in the social behavioral field is required: Marriage & Family Counseling; Counseling Psychology; Clinical Psychology; Clinical Counseling; Clinical Mental Health Counseling; Counseling with an emphasis in Marriage, Family and Child Counseling.

Must either be currently registered with the California Board of Behavioral Sciences (BBS) as an Associate Marriage and Family Therapist; licensed LMFT/LCSW/LPCC.

Bilingual in English and Spanish Required. Must have own vehicle, a valid CA driver's license and a good driving record.
